HEALTHY HEROES



Let's all work together to stay healthy this flu sesaon

Please keep your child home if they have:



Persistent Cough, Green snotty nose

Check for shortness of breath, sore throat, swollen glands, earache



Fevers or lathargic

Check for rashes, itching (Hand,Foot & Mouth, Chicken pox, School sores)



Upset Stomach

They have had diarrhoea or vomiting in the last 24 hours they MUST stay at home



Eye infection

Thick mucus or puss draining from the eye or swollen face

When your child is sick:

- Have a back up plan We understand that the work pressure but it's also our duty of care to keep all children and staff safe. It's important to work together and stop sickness before it spreads.
- Let us know what they are sick with incase it turns into an outbreak
- Inform us that you are going to be absent either on the childcare now app or email or phone the centre.
- Provide a doctors certificate if you have reached your 42 allowable absences for the financial year
