Sun Safety & Warm Weather HATS AND SUNSCREEN - So we aren't sure what happened with Winter and not sure if we will see Spring but the warmer weather is upon us! With the weather warming up we ask that you help us to keep your children sun safe. We ask that when you arrive if the children are outside that you ensure that your child has sunscreen and a hat on before coming out to play. With the business of the morning transitions of arrivals and settling children in we don't want anyone to miss out on getting their sunscreen on which can happen if Educators are busy with communications or settlings an upset child. There will be a sunscreen station in the foyer and also in each

We ask that your child's hat stays at the centre and we will wash them each week so they always have their hat available. Our team will ensure that the children get their sunscreen and hats on throughout the rest of the day if they are going outside.
